**SUSPENSION OF BOROUGH ORDINANCE 19-09  
PLASTIC BAGS**

**WHEREAS**, on September 4, 2019, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Woodland Park, County of Passaic, State of New Jersey adopted Borough Ordinance 19-09, an ordinance to regulate the use of single-use plastic bags and paper bags by retail establishments and promote the use of reusable bags within the Borough; and

**WHEREAS**, said ordinance is scheduled to become effective April 1, 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, due to CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) concerns and uncertainties, the Mayor and Council have determined that compliance with the scheduled effective date will cause hardship and confusion on the part of the retailers and the public; and

**WHEREAS**, this hardship and confusion needs to be addressed by delaying the scheduled effective date of the ordinance to a date, yet determined, to be established by the Mayor and Council;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Mayor and Council hereby suspend the scheduled implementation date of Borough Ordinance 19-09 to a date to be determined by the Mayor and Council.
